Not so much a 'who-dunnit' - we know that, shortly after the play starts - it is more of a psychological drama which brings us straight into the middle of a gripping story with a bang! Then the action flies off at unexpected tangents until the ending, which is ingeniously surprising. The play may be described as sheer entertainment.
