THE MASKERS YOUTH THEATRE

The Maskers Youth Theatre was formed three years ago to provide an opportunity for young people to become involved in theatre and to have an identity of their own. It has attracted a wide range of people of ages up to 25 and from varied backgrounds, many of whom have never been on the stage before.

This is the third production by the Maskers Youth Theatre. The inaugural production was Zigger Zagger, a classic youth play about football fans, and it received excellent publicity and good critical acclaim. Last year the ambitious production of the musical The Dracula Spectacula played to packed houses in The Gantry and at The Plaza, with some people coming to see the show several times.

The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe uses some of the experience gained in 'Dracula' and, in particular, welcomes the return of the band Steppin' Out. 'Lion' represents a change from previous shows in that it has been directed and produced by two members of the cast of the previous shows. It is also aimed primarily at a younger audience, although it is hoped it will have an appeal for all ages.

The Maskers Youth Theatre is a part of the Maskers Theatre Company, a Southampton based amateur drama group celebrating its 21st birthday this year. The Company performs regularly at the Nuffield Theatre, The Gantry, The Plaza and Mottisfont Abbey with a wide selection of shows. Recent productions have included The Rover, A Day in the Death of Joe Egg, Rebecca, and When the Wind Blows. Members of the Youth Theatre are automatically members of the whole company and regularly take part in their productions.
