The play is a profound examination of human nature, exploring our vulnerability and refusal to acknowledge the destruction we are causing until it is too late.

This is a great opportunity to see, in a theatre ideally suited to both the play's grandeur and its human scale, what is regarded by many, as Shakespeare's greatest work.
