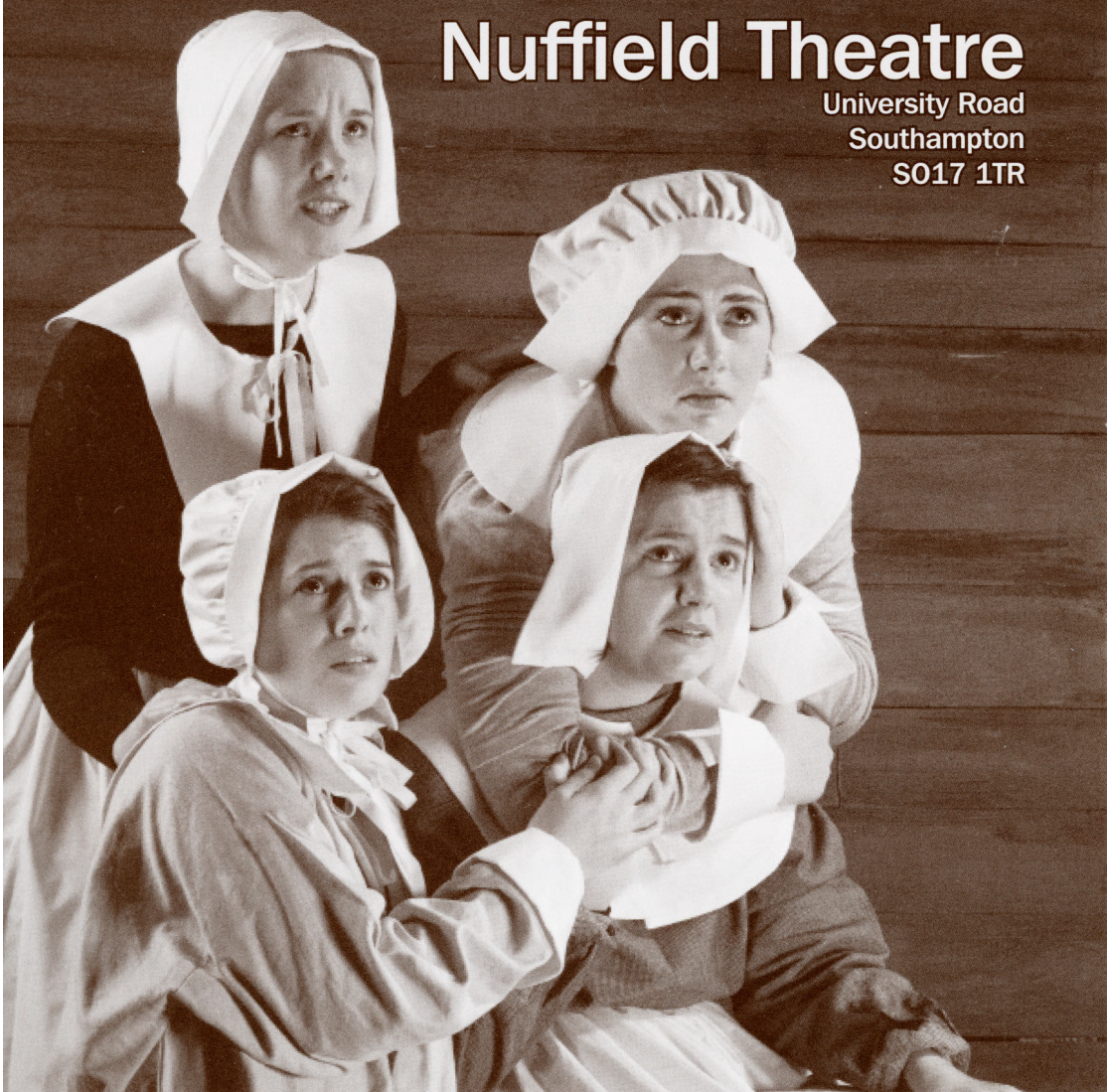

Arthur Miller's classic parable of mass hysteria draws a chilling parallel between the Salem witch-hunt of 1692 - 'one of the strangest and most awful chapters in human history' - and the McCarthyism which gripped America in the 1950s.

The story of how the small community of Salem is stirred into madness by superstition, paranoia and malice, culminating in a violent climax. The events that led to the Witch Trials began with the seemingly inexplicable behaviour of two young girls and ended in accusation, violence and death.

By the time the hysteria had spent itself, 24 people had died - nineteen were hanged on Gallows Hill in Salem Town, others died in prison.

A powerful drama not to be missed.
