You are welcome to picnic in the beautiful gardens of Hamptworth Lodge from 6pm (from 2.30pm on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 July). Tables cannot be accommodated within the seating area, you are advised to place seats for the show and take your picnic to another part of the garden. Patrons are advised to bring low back chairs, rugs etc, as NO seating is provided. In addition you are advised to bring warm jumpers or coats, as it can get cold even on the warmest of evenings. Hopefully the sun will shine for the matinee performance and patrons are advised to bring hats and sunscreen.

Any decision to cancel a performance due to bad weather will be taken just before the start of the play, if the show does not start patrons may then be offered a ticket for another night. No refunds will be given. No unaccompanied children under 16.

A smoking area is provided outside the Archery Lawn.

Ample free parking and toilet facilities will be provided.

There is a short walk of approx. 100 metres to the performance area.

Parking/facilities available for disabled patrons.

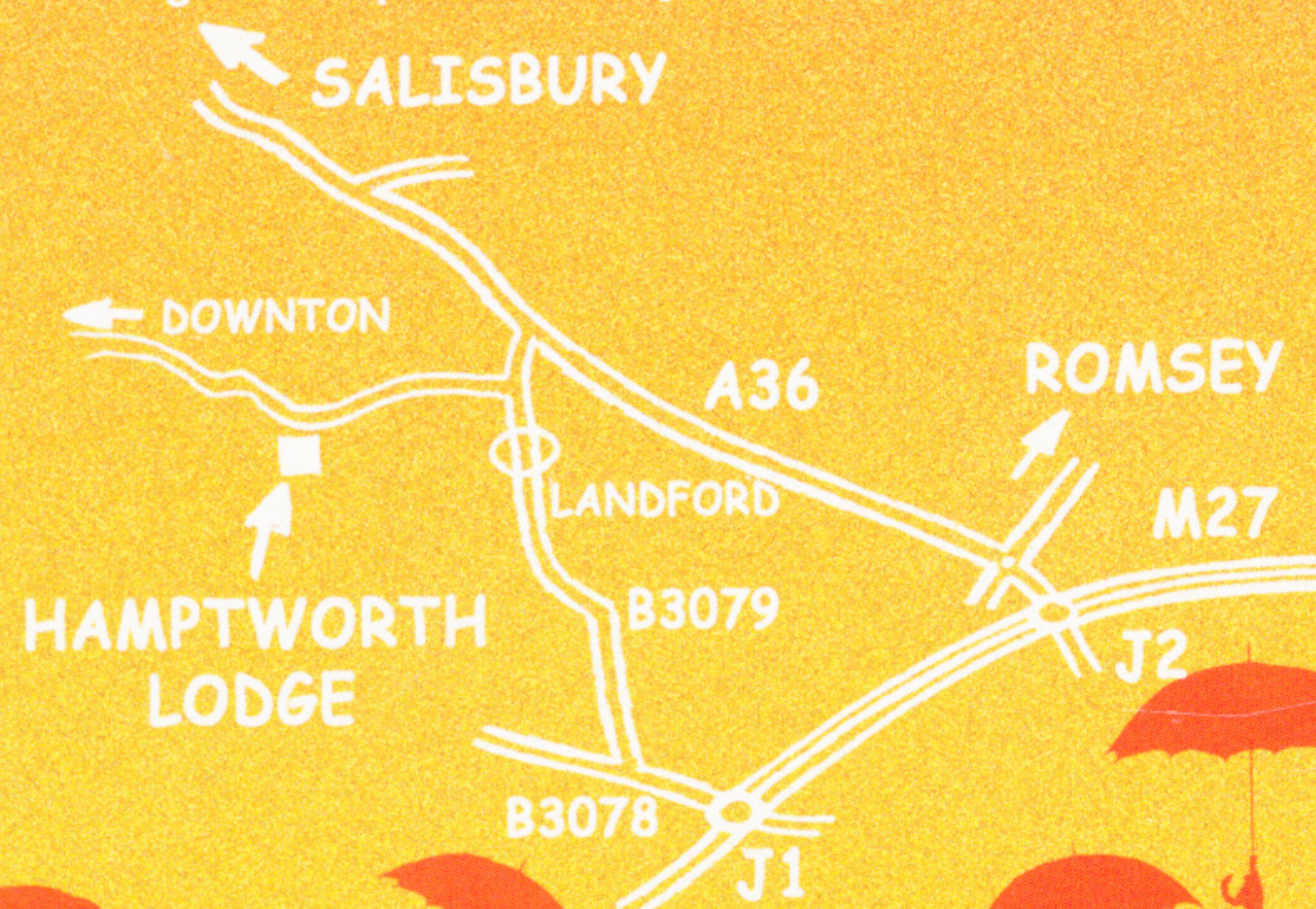
Hot and cold light refreshments will be available.
