The play concerns two characters, Peter and Jerry. Peter is a middle-class publishing executive with a wife, two daughters, two cats and two parakeets. Jerry is an isolated and disheartened man. They meet on a park bench in Central Park, New York on a sunny Sunday afternoon. Jerry is desperate to have a meaningful conversation with another human being and intrudes on Peter's peaceful state by interrogating him and forcing him to listen to stories and the reason behind his visit to the zoo. The elements of ironic humour and unrelenting dramatic suspense are brought to a climax when Jerry brings his victim down to his own savage level.

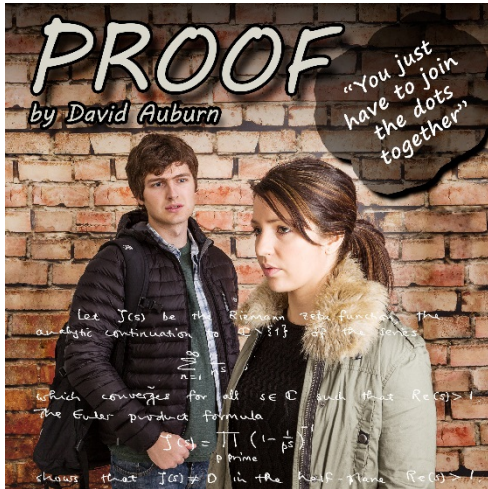
